- **23 - 25 August, 2021**
Three-day hands-on workshop for the ten winners or winning teams. Food, accommodation and travel paid for by OASE.

Round 2 of the competition

- **26 August, 2021**
Start of the second round of the competition
The participants will be given information about the task and the materials that they can use during the workshop.
- **Until 30 September, 2021**
Submission period for the final versions of the designs from the second round of the competition
- **October 2021**
Announcement of the three best designs
- **October 2021**
The three winners are presented with their prizes at a ceremony. One night's accommodation at a hotel and travel paid for by OASE.

The selection process

- The competition and the selection process are subject to German substantive law.

- The jury will review all submissions that meet the requirements set out in the „The brief“ and „Required documents“ sections and that have been submitted before the deadline by participants who meet the criteria set out in this document.
- The jury will choose the stated number of winners for each round of the competition. To do this, jury members will assess the submissions at their discretion. Jury decisions will be made by simple majority.
- The organiser will inform the participants as soon as the jury has reached a decision.
- The decision of the jury is final.
- If the prize consists of participating in events (e.g. workshops or trade fairs), the prize can only be claimed by the prize winner personally.
- In the case of non-participation in events (e.g. workshops or trade fairs), cash alternatives will not be available.

Transfer of rights
